What is Let us Tell You?

Let Us Tell You is a film project from Mortal Fools' Youth Theatre.

It is available to watch now via Mortal Fools' YouTube channel.

The films are for young people and people interested in young people's contemporary issues.

It consists of two separate films, featuring the voices, feelings and insights of young people on film.

The films are inspired by two questions:

& If you could say one thing to other young people right now what would it be?

If you could change one thing for young people right now what would it be?

Mortal Fools' Youth Theatre share their response to those two questions in the films.

What are the films like and about?

Both films contain a mix of live action, animation, narration, special effects and music.

The films will make you think, reflect, laugh and are positive.

Film 1 is called *My Monster Arrived*.

Running time is just under 7 minutes.

It was filmed in Prudhoe Park, Northumberland in wooded areas and green spaces.

My Monster Arrived playfully explores monsters as a visual representation of fear.

The symbol of "monsters" is used to represent young people's worries, anxiety, uncertainty and fears both real and imagined.

Monsters are not depicted in a scary way.

The film shows a young girl, sad and fearful in her bedroom, until she starts to draw and then we delve into her imagination.

The film depicts her drawings, brought to life through a mixture of animation, live action and special effects.

The film closes by returning to the real world, and the young people start playing "monsters".

Film 2 is called **Thank You For Listening**.

Running time is just over 10minutes long.

It was filmed in Prudhoe Park, Northumberland in wooded areas and green spaces, Northumberland urban areas and young people's bedroom.

The film mimics a nature documentary.

It observes a collection of teenagers out the in the wild, struggling with a confusing contemporary world.

The film explores themes of identity, self-expression, growing up, society pressure, friendship and confidence.

It does this through third person narration, looking into mirrors whilst hearing internal monologues, a voicemail from a younger self, YouTube style vlogs and speaking to camera, giving advice to other young people.

This is a positive film for anyone trying to figure out who they are.

How do you watch Let Us Tell You?

It is available to watch now via Mortal Fools' YouTube channel.

You can watch the two films any time.

You do not have to watch the films back to back.

Is it free to watch?

Yes.

The animation was created by freelance North East animator Sheryl Jenkins.

The project was funded by Arts Council England, Northumberland County Council, UK Youth, Community Foundation and Prudhoe Town Council.
